  - 🗆 Natura 2000 SPA
  - Protected sites on national level
  - Biosphere Reserves






Pilot implementation workflow

To improve the quality of the pilot and provide more attractive and innovative content a new dataset was developed:

Ecotourism Destinations point database (265 sites)






Ecotourism Destinations dataset content:

- 265 ecotourism destination location
- Name of the destination (HU and EN)
- Settlement name (HU)
- Weblink of the destination (HU and EN if available EN service)
- Coordinates of the ecotourism destination in HU HD 1972 projection and in WGS



## Pilot implementation workflow (UML schema)





#### System web services integration

The USERS of the Pilot should be able to do in the client side:

- Turn on and of the different layers e.g. I.9 datasets
- Display OS map contents (eg: GE) for the navigation
- Display the ecotourism destination dataset and if there is internet access on the field, browse the supplied websites for detailed information on the visited site


