

 An MSc degree is an internationally recognised postgraduate academic qualification. UNIGIS partner universities are able to offer the opportunity to graduate with an MSc in GIScience or to be certified with a Professional Diploma.

MSc Degrees

- Master of Science (Geographic Information Science and Systems)
 - 2+ year postgraduate study programme in GIScience for working professionals who want to become qualified as project, team or department leaders.
 - Students will build profound knowledge of concepts of GIScience and applications at a postgraduate level.

Professional Diploma / Certificates

- Professional Diploma / Certificate in GIS
 1+ year certificate program for working
 professionals who need to efficiently and
 effectively acquire broad competences in
 methods and tools of GIS.
 - Participants advance their professional development in application-oriented skills and develop a basic conceptual understanding of GIScience.

 <u>Excellence Prize</u> is awarded to students having submitted the best MISc theses during the previous academic year, accepted for graduation at one of the UNIGIS partner universities worldwide.
